**Remote Learning Memo to Families**

Good afternoon, Washington Families,

First, I would like to thank you all in advance for your patience and understanding during this ever-changing time. Information is changing by the hour, and we all need to be flexible in changes that may occur. Thank you to those of you who have checked in and asked questions. I want to assure you that I will continue to be available by e-mail and phone.

**Here is what you need to know about our Remote Learning plan at this moment:**

- **Wednesday between 8:00am and 7:00pm**, please come to the school to pick up supplies for your child. Even if your child already has a Chromebook at home, there are additional materials to pick up. **Please bring an empty backpack with you, come to the door, ring the doorbell, and we will greet you at the door and bring the supplies to you.**
- Students are expected to start their Remote Learning on **Thursday, March 19th**. Students will have a menu of activities and should NOT be sitting in front of a computer all day. Please follow the directions on the menu that you will receive from your child's teacher.
- If your child becomes sick during this time or is unable to complete the activities sent home, **please call the office and leave a message that your child is "absent"**. If your child is sick, please kindly leave your child's symptoms.
- Please **check your e-mail regularly** for communication from teachers and administration. If you do not have an e-mail, you can set one up for free through Google (<https://support.google.com/mail/answer/56256?hl=en>). If you do not have internet access, please contact Kelli Colarusso at 495-3463 and let her know.
- Granite State Communications is offering free internet and installation to families in Washington who need it. Please call 603-529-9911 and ask for Kate, their customer service representative, for more information.
- Teachers will have access to their voicemail, so please call the school at any time and follow the prompts to leave a message for your child's teacher. Teachers will get back to you but the number may show up as "Unknown," as they will be using their personal phones when they aren't in the building.
- Information about food delivery will be coming soon. Please stay tuned for that.
- The CDC has recommended that people not congregate in groups of more than 10. Please try to adhere to this suggestion (unless of course your family is larger than that!).
