**Article 01** To see if the school district will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Hillsboro Deering School Board and the Hillsboro-Deering Federation of Teachers (AFT Local #2348) which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

**Fiscal Year Estimated Increase**

2022-2023 \$280,465

2023-2024 \$294,151

2024-2025 \$279,790

And further to raise and appropriate \$280,465 for the 2022-2023 fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the most recent collective bargaining agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. (Majority vote required)
