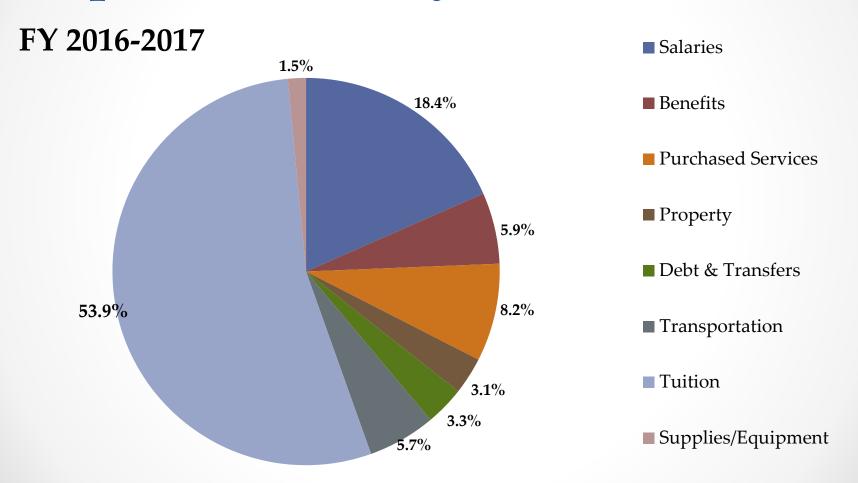

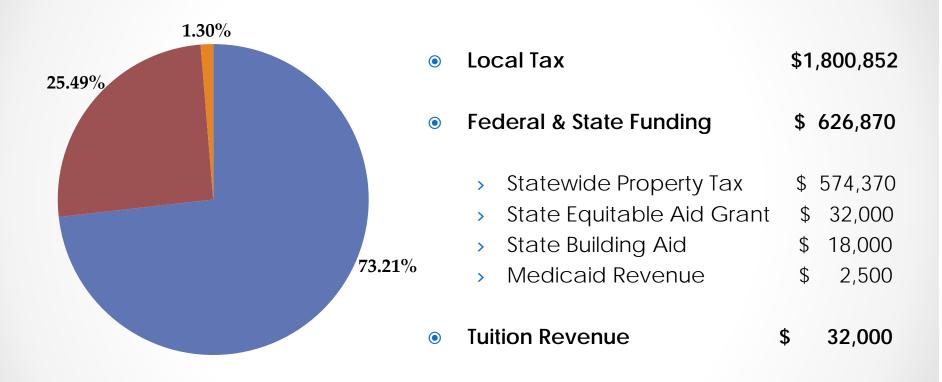

- SAU #34 Budget
  - o Washington Apportionment \$135,174
  - o Total SAU Budget \$1,020,109
    - Includes contractual raises and an increase for non-contracted employees
  - Hillsboro-Deering and Windsor also assigned apportionments
  - Majority vote of all the school district voters in this SAU
  - o If defeated, Washington Apportionment \$134,742 and total SAU Budget \$1,017,045

- Funds from State and Federal Aid
  - o Food Service \$25,000
  - o Federal and State Projects \$50,000
  - These appropriations have offsetting revenues from school lunch sales and State and Federal revenues and do not affect the tax rate

- Appropriate \$10,000 to Special Education Expendable Trust Fund
  - o From any unreserved fund balance at end of FY 2015-16
  - Occurs only if budget has positive ending balance
  - To fund mandatory unanticipated Special Education expenses

- Appropriate \$10,000 to Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund
  - o From any unreserved fund balance at end of FY 2015-16
  - Occurs only if budget has positive ending balance
  - To fund school building maintenance and repair expenses

- Appropriate \$120,000 to Replace Roof
  - o \$70,000 withdrawn from Maintenance Expendable Trust
  - o \$50,000 raised through general taxation

- Retain 2.5% Contingency Fund
  - o Adopt RSA 198:4-b, II to allow the school district to retain up to 2.5%
  - o To be used to reduce the tax rate or as a revenue source for emergency expenditures and over expenditures (RSA 32:11)
  - This retained fund balance is not cumulative
