

PUBLIC USE OF SCHOOL DISTRICT BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

The Washington School Board believes that the school building and grounds should be available for use by non-profit community organizations and groups that promote the welfare of the community, including use as a registration and polling place for voters when not used for regular purposes. The School Board recognizes its responsibility to safeguard school property. Provisions for use of school property by individuals and groups which make a profit from such use and for out-of-town organizations will be made. It is the responsibility of the Superintendent to develop and implement procedures* for the public use of school district buildings and grounds.

In accordance with the School Board's policy, there shall be no discrimination on the basis of age, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, race, color, marital status, familial status, disability, religion or national origin. for employment in, participation in, admission or access to, or operation and administration of any educational program or activity in the School District.
