Title I is a federally funded program designed to provide services to meet the educational needs of students who are at risk of not meeting the National Common Core Standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics. All Title I services are supplemental to regular classroom instruction and school curriculum.

Academic Interventionists are certified educators who provide supplemental math and reading instruction during Rtl scheduled blocks. The positions are funded by Title I.

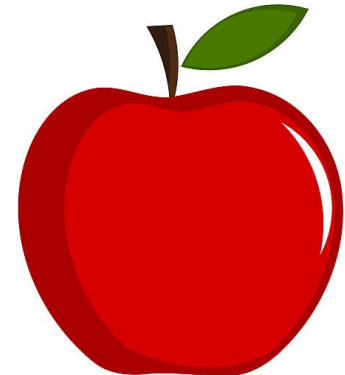
