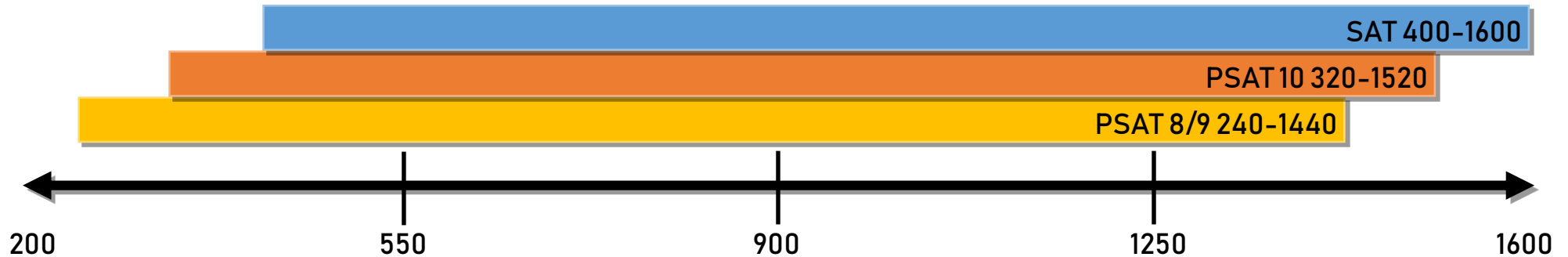

What is a benchmark?

Benchmarks are the scores that have been identified as what students should reach in order to show that they are college and career ready.

What is a percentile?

The percentiles in this chart were created using national data to identify “the percentage of students whose score is equal to or lower than [this] score” (College Board, 2019).

Why are the test score ranges different among tests?

Test scores grow with the test takers, so students and parents can see progress toward the final SAT assessment. Striving to achieve the benchmark on each test can indicate progress toward overall readiness and preparation for college and career.

What is the real difference among PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and the SAT?

The SAT is a test used by colleges and universities nationwide to measure a “high school student's readiness for college, and provide colleges with one common data point that can be used to compare all applicants” (The Princeton Review, 2019). The PSAT 10 is a practice of this test that can help students and parents plan for and prepare for the actual SAT, as well as qualify students to begin the process of applying for scholarships (College Board, 2018). The most recently developed test, the PSAT 8/9 is a different test, although similarly styled, that helps predict readiness for the SAT, as well as AP courses in early high school (Witte, 2017).

What if I need help or practice before I take these tests?

Practicing and studying are good strategies when preparing for any test or assessment.

The tutoring website *Khan Academy* partnered with the College Board in 2017 to offer free Official SAT Prep and practice. In fact, “studying for the SAT for 20 hours on Khan Academy’s free Official SAT Practice is associated with an average score gain of 115 points” (Khan Academy, 2017).
